Footnotes

JUST LIKE JIMMY, never far back while racing in behind the leaders, eased out on the second turn to secure room, commenced a sweeping six wide run about the five-sixteenths pole and closed determinedly to wear down CONSCIENCE CLEAR. The latter went up early to vie for the lead from between horses, gained the edge early on the backstretch, went along under careful handling, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage, then could not last. DOMINIQUE'S CAT moved up early to force the pace four wide, loomed a strong threat from between foes for the final furlong but wasn't good enough. CORPORATE STORM, within easy striking distance while four or five wide throughout, lacked a final response. SIDE BRUSH, outrun for a half, reached contention approaching the stretch, improved position through the late stages but couldn't seriously threaten. IT'S SO SIMPLE gained a narrow advantage along the inside early while dueling with CONSCIENCE CLEAR and DOMINIQUE'S CAT, lost the edge on the backstretch to CONSCIENCE CLEAR, continued forwardly until the furlong grounds and weakened. ROSE CREEK drifted out at the break bumping CHIEF'S HOGAN, raced in contention to the end of the backstretch and weakened. LIKE TO TALK, unhurried early and four or five wide throughout, failed to threaten. CHIEF'S HOGAN, bumped soon after the start and checked in tight quarters, saved ground but wasn't a factor. EIGHTIES was outrun.
