DARK SKY attended the pace along the inside, shifted to the outside entering the stretch, wore down the dueling leaders and edged clear through the final yards. FORD GALLOP was allowed to settle into stride three wide, came five wide to make a steady advance and was up in time to earn the place. ANACHINI rushed up from between horses to dispute the pace three wide, weakened slightly during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. KIAWAH'S MAGIC was away alertly and angled in to set the pace, was collared before going a quarter, dueled for the lead off of the inside to the furlong marker and gave way. SILENT STREET was unhurried into stride, made a mild rally circling six wide but failed to seriously threaten. TIME FLIES was forwardly placed three wide, but weakened from between horses entering the stretch and faded. NADESHIKO contended between through the turn and tired. THE HIGH QUEEN was shuffled back at the start and was never a factor. CHINCHILLA showed little. AIDAN saved ground to no avail.
