Footnotes

SOUPEUR SPECTACULAR tracked the pace three wide, forged a narrow lead entering the stretch and gradually edged clear. LONGBOARDER tugged his way forward three wide past the grandstand first time by, attended the pace under a snug hold, came four wide and finished well but was unable to reach the winner. VERSAILLES ROAD was close up along the inside, made his bid between horses before going six furlongs, weakened toward the inside in the drive and settled for a minor award. DAVID D settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch and was making up ground late. HARRODS CREEK was unhurried into stride, came four wide and improved position through the lane. BLUE MON was unhurried, made a mild rally between horses but failed to threaten. BUCHERON settled near the back of the pack, angled out to make a belated gain but was never a factor. AVIE'S PEGASUS attended the pace between horses, but came up empty entering the stretch and dropped out. BIGSHOT passed only the tiring ones. DONT POKE THE BEAR settled in the second flight and failed to respond. ENGINE ROOM opened clear to set the pace, was collared before going six furlongs and gave way readily once

headed. GRAND REALITY (ARG) was forwardly placed along the inside through the second turn and stopped.
