BAY HEAD settled in hand, commenced a sweeping move four wide through the second turn, struck the front entering the stretch, opened clear and held safely. CONSERVE hopped at the start, was unhurried into stride, circled five wide to make a bold bid but was unable to reach the winner. BARRY SHORTPANTS was unhurried, settled near the tail of the field, advanced between horses, tipped out six wide entering the stretch and was making up ground. BOLTING BROWN made an early move five wide, drew even after a half, gained a brief lead leaving the second turn, was swamped entering the stretch and gave way. HEAVENLY SHILOH dueled two wide, dropped off of the leaders on the second turn, went evenly thereafter and ended on even terms with DILLO for the fifth spot. The latter was rank to place, pulled to contention between horses, steadied near the seven-sixteenths, moved up on the second turn, steadied again while lacking room near the quarter pole and flattened. GIACOSLEW was close up three wide, dropped back a bit on the

second turn and was not a factor from that point. EXPENSIVE CANDY failed to respond. BATTLEMENTS showed little. A BETTER TOMORROW vied for the lead along the inside, disputed the issue through the second turn, but gave way readily entering the stretch. THE TEUFF WAY was through early. CEEBETT'S SOUL was close up five wide, stopped before going six furlongs, pulled up entering the stretch but walked off.
