SILVERBULLETDAY checked in tight nearing the first turn, gained a forward position along the inside, raced within easy striking distance in hand, swung out four wide to commence her rally at the half-mile ground, took over midway of the second turn, then was under solid hand urging to prove clearly best. EXTENDED APPLAUSE, never far back and saving ground for six furlongs, angled outside SILVERBULLETDAY to follow that one approaching the stretch, loomed menacingly for the drive but failed to respond as second best. GRAND DEED went up outside early to stalk the leaders, edged in when clear, moved with the winner from between foes approaching the stretch but came up empty when the test came. PERFECT STING, outrun for six furlongs, made a mild bid to reach contention in the upper stretch but failed to continue. FANTASY LAKE, bumped at the start, raced in a striking position for six furlongs but failed to offer a further response while holding her position. APPEALING PHYLLY went up inside to vie for the lead on the first turn, reached the front briefly nearing the end of the backstretch, held on well for six furlongs and weakened thereafter. SECOND DEGREE failed to reach contention. REMUDA leaned in at the start bumping FANTASY LAKE and was never close. SECRET PARTNER was outrun. STORMIN HANNA moved to the fore soon after the start, was joined soon after from the inside by APPEALING PHYLLY and gave way readily after three-quarters. COLD AWAKENING was done early.
