Footnotes

NAJRAN moved up early to vie for the lead outside of SOARING FREE, raced four wide, took over approaching the stretch, kicked clear into the upper stretch, then increased his advantage under solid hand urging as much the best. FLYING FREE, well placed while near the inside between horses early, moved inside on the turn, came out four or five wide for the drive, couldn't menace the winner but clearly bested the rest. PREMIER PERFORMER, outrun until the stretch and six or seven wide most of the way, improved position but couldn't challenge the top two. DANTHEBLUEGRASSMAN, outsprinted early, raced in behind horses three wide until approaching the stretch, came out five wide for the drive and was empty the last eighth. SOARING FREE gained a slim lead early, raced near the inside while dueling with NAJRAN, lost the advantage to that one two furlongs out and weakened thereafter. RICHEST HALF, outrun from the start, raced inside until the final quarter, came out five wide for the drive but couldn't muster a closing account. SKY TERRACE, six wide on the backstretch, was finished midway on the turn. ECSTATIC drifted out at the start bumping FLYING FREE while breaking alertly, raced in contention inside for a half and tired. SHAH JEHAN, well placed while stalking the pace four or five wide into the stretch, faded in the drive.
