**Footnotes**

GRANDE MELODY (IRE), a bit sluggish to begin, settled in behind rivals, was unhurried, worked her way forward near the inside on the far turn, maneuvered out five wide for the drive, caught front-running BLESS YOU about the sixteenth pole and drove well clear under hand encouragement. BLESS YOU, forwardly placed near the inside from the outset, moved up four wide approaching the final quarter, took over from pacesetter CUABA, was clear for the last eighth but not a match for the winner in the late going. CAPE AUGUSTA raced within easy striking distance near the inside from the beginning, eased out to move with the winner while inside that one four wide in the upper stretch but couldn't match strides in the final furlong. OCEAN BEAUTY, outrun for six furlongs and between horses three wide, came out seven abreast for the drive and improved position. CUABA sprinted to the fore near the inside early, made the pace to the head of the stretch and tired. JILL INDY PULPIT raced in contention four or five wide for nearly six furlongs and weakened. ANGEL FLYING drifted out while breaking a bit awkwardly, settled soon after, reached easy striking distance between foes three or four wide on the backstretch, continued forwardly to the lane and was empty. DOENY GHOST chased the pace four wide for six furlongs and weakened. MILLE LACS tired out going a half.
