SCATMAN opened clear and angled in to dictate terms, kept on through a prolonged drive, and maintained a diminishing advantage. EVER SO LUCKY attended the pace along the inside, shifted out entering the stretch, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. KEEP UP was allowed to settle, angled out and split horses six wide entering the stretch, and finished willingly to earn the show. CYBER SECRET tracked the pace three wide, but drifted out through the drive and weakened. DAYS RIDE contended off of the inside, came four wide but lacked the needed late response. IN THE BEAT was unhurried into stride, finished with a late rally between horses and improved position through the lane. HALON saved ground to little avail. SHRILL was hustled along four wide through the turn and tired. SENOR DEHERE (AUS) chased four wide for five furlongs and dropped out. NOTORIETY settled five wide and failed to respond.
