Footnotes

LITTLE B ROSSON, never far back while following the pace four wide, fanned six wide into the stretch and was hard ridden to prevail. WHO'S COUNTING settled two wide early, went along under patient handling, split horses four wide in the final furlong and was going well to earn the place. QUICK NOTICE, in hand early while tracking the leaders four wide, moved between horses into the lane, had aim in the drive and wasn't good enough. PLENTY O LADY gained the edge early while dueling five wide, edged in a bit on the turn while increasing her advantage, made the pace into the final furlong and weakened grudgingly. LITTLE SOMETHIN, well placed near the inside early, made a menacing run between foes three wide into the final furlong and couldn't sustain the needed momentum. WORD GETS AROUND settled inside, was steadied at the five-sixteenths pole when lacking room, came around a tiring TRICKLE ME GOOD in the upper stretch, moved back inside but never fired. TRICKLE ME GOOD vied for the lead early while inside of PLENTY O LADY two or three wide and tired leaving the turn. LA SUSA, six wide much of the way, never was a factor.
