Footnotes

RAVEL went up early to press front-running SLEEK HUNTER in four wide early, took over from that one leaving the second turn, kicked clear and widened when kept to his task. PROM SHOES settled two wide early, was unhurried, worked his way out seven wide leaving the second turn and was second best. ALL MAN, never far back and four or five wide, was asked for more midway on the far turn, raced prominently into the final furlong and lacked a response. SPECIAL EVENT, unhurried early, inched forward between horses on the turn, continued between rivals into the lane and improved position while not a serious threat. SMOKEYJONESUTTON raced within easy striking distance between horses to the upper stretch and flattened out. SLEEK HUNTER angled in early while gaining the lead, made the pace under pressure from the winner to the head of the stretch and weakened. BACETTO, a bit sluggish to begin, angled in three wide early, was outrun to the lane, came out eight wide for the drive and improved position while never a threat. LUMBERJACK CAT gained a forward position inside early, raced in contention for nearly six furlongs and weakened. GALLOPING HOME was outrun. PROMISE'LLBEHOME, a bit edgy in the gate prior to the start, was never prominent. APACHE ROAD, up close between foes early, remained in contention to the head of the stretch and tired.
