TEMPO APPROVED attended the pace three deep, drew even with five-sixteenths to run, opened clear entering the stretch, was kept to task and increased her advantage. DARLIN' DIANE was awkward into stride, settled saving ground, commenced her rally with five-sixteenths to run, angled out seven wide entering the stretch and was making up ground. PAOLI PRINCESS tucked in and settled in hand while never far back, shifted out leaving the second turn, loomed a danger entering the stretch but flattened during the drive. VISION OF LIZ was unhurried into stride, circled five wide through the second turn and improved position through the lane. SISTER RESISTOR was allowed to settle, advanced between horses, came four wide but lacked the needed late response. JARDENIA was forwardly placed three wide to the stretch but faltered between rivals and faded. BLACK TULIP tracked four wide, but tired entering the stretch and retreated. PURE VALUE contended toward the inside but came up empty after six furlongs and faded. MAKENZIE'S MAGIC passed only the tiring ones. TAP MAGIC was away in good order, angled in to set the pace, was collared nearing the three-eighths pole and gave way

readily once headed. SMARTY PARTY was never a factor. BYE BYE BLACKBIRD was through after a half.
