Footnotes

MEGNOG settled saving ground, closed the gap through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch, wore down DREAM PEGASUS and edged clear late. DREAM PEGASUS settled in hand, ranged up four wide to make a bold bid, opened clear entering the stretch, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. SLANDER was slow into stride, made a long drive circling six wide, loomed large entering the stretch but flattened in the drive. LILY HANNAH was allowed to settle, split rivals entering the stretch and improved position. HOLIDAY BROAD settled between horses, angled out six wide entering the stretch but lacked the needed late punch. DODIE JO attended the pace along the inside, moved up in the two path on the second turn, split horses and angled in entering the stretch but came up empty in the drive and faded. SWAKOPMUND contended three wide, forged a brief lead with five-sixteenths to run, but

weakened entering the stretch and gave way. MORE DISCREET was hustled along four wide, offered a mild bid between horses but failed to sustain the drive. SERMONETTES HOPE failed to respond. FASIG GIRL was fractious in the gate, was unhurried five wide and was never a factor. SISTER GENEVRA prompted the pace between horses for a half and dropped out. PIQUE OUT was fractious in the gate, set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed after six furlongs and stopped.
