FIELD CAT gained the lead inside early, drew well clear into the backstretch, had things his way while showing the way and won under a mild hand ride. PAY RANSOM, within striking distance, saved ground to the stretch but failed to muster a closing threat. THREE WONDERS, outrun early, wasn't a threat while improving position seven wide. BALLARD STREET, within striking distance to the stretch, came up empty in the drive. SPLENDEED, also in a striking position to the stretch, weakened when the test came. PRIVILEGED weakened nearing the stretch. SOKOL wasn't a factor in an even trip. GALLOPING GEORGE was outrun as was MIRAKI. FLYING METRO appeared rank early while drifting out on the first turn and remained wide.
