SALTY COUNTESSA gained a slight edge early, moved clear on the turn, made the balance of the pace and increased her lead late under hand urging. RODEO FAN settled in behind the leaders early, angled to rail when entering the stretch and couldn't threaten the winner while fully extended to outfinish FRENCH LADY. The latter, well placed from the start, ranged up outside the winner for the final furlong but was empty. LITTLE BERTIE forced the pace four wide into the stretch and weakened. EAGER LADY bobbed at the start and was checked in tight quarters, was outrun for a half, swung out six wide for the drive but couldn't threaten. JILTED PAYMASTER drifted out at the start, went up to press the winner from the outside, held on well for a half and tired. UNFORGETTABLE BABE moved inside early but was finished upon going a half.
