Footnotes

AFFLUENT, lightly rated from early on but racing six wide much of the way, inched after the leaders approaching the stretch while continuing steadily and well off the inside, reached the front in the final sixteenth and prevailed under strong hand urging. GOLDEN APPLES (IRE) hopped in the air at the start to trail, settled inside, advanced along the rail on the second turn, eased out and split foes four wide in the upper stretch, poked her head in front between calls about the sixteenth pole, then wasn't quite good enough in a game try. SNOW DANCE, a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, moved up soon after the break to gain a slight lead while dueling outside of LIGHT DANCER, lost the advantage to that one between calls around the first turn and into the backstretch, took over again just prior to going a half, made the pace into the final furlong and weakened. CASUAL FEAT, well placed early while near the inside between foes, eased out five wide on the backstretch, angled in a bit on the second turn, was put to a drive leaving the three furlong marker, loomed a strong threat inside the winner entering the final furlong and came up empty. ING ING (FR), unhurried early while edging in behind the leaders, moved between rivals four wide nearing the final quarter, briefly lacked room, awaited for the winner to clear at the furlong grounds, angled five wide but lacked a final response. REINE DE ROMANCE (IRE), rated in behind horses early while four or five wide, came out farther on the course approaching the final quarter and failed to rally. VOODOO DANCER, well placed early while in behind the leaders, dropped to the rail approaching the stretch to make a solid run nearing the eighth pole but flattened out late. LIVE YOUR DREAMS angled in soon after the start, raced four or five wide while outrun to the end of the backstretch, came out eight or nine wide for the drive but was empty. SWEETEST THING saved ground until nearing the stretch, moved out six wide but couldn't menace. LIGHT DANCER moved up near the inside to vie for the lead early, gained a clear advantage between calls early on the backstretch while battling with SNOW DANCE, lost the edge back to that one just prior to going a half, continued forwardly until entering the far turn and weakened gradually thereafter.
