Footnotes

INTERNATIONAL CAT, steadied lightly near the inside just after the start, was taken in hand, raced two or three wide for six furlongs while unhurried, circled foes eight wide into the stretch and closed determinedly under urging to be along in time. LEWIS MICHAEL, unhurried early, raced four or five wide, inched up on the far turn, continued five or six wide into the stretch, reached the front in deep stretch between calls but couldn't contain the winner's surge. ELIZABUL, well placed while racing between foes three or four wide, moved boldly approaching the final furlong, gained a slim, brief led, then couldn't sustain the needed momentum. PETION STATION gained the lead early, raced two or three wide, battled with MAGNUS ONE into the final furlong and grudgingly weakened. MONSIEUR DANSEUR, outrun for nearly six furlongs, offered a mild gain. GALLOWES raced prominently for six furlongs while near the inside and weakened. SMOKE EM AGAIN, well placed four or five wide, was asked for his best a quarter-mile out but flattened out when straightened for the drive. MAGNUS ONE went up early to press front-running PETION STATION four wide, gained a slight advantage approaching the stretch but weakened soon after. DEVILOFARUSH weakened on the far turn. SILVER TITAN tracked the pace five wide for six furlongs and tired.
