Footnotes

WILDCAT FAN broke sharply in front, was eased back to stalk the pace four wide, took over leaving the eighth pole, then was hard ridden to hold OCEAN CURRENT safe. OCEAN CURRENT moved near the inside early to gain the edge, shook off GENTLY leaving the turn, lost the lead to the winner inside the furlong grounds and held on stubbornly the remainder. DURAJAZZ, never far back, made a solid run six wide into the upper stretch but couldn't make up the difference. SUMNEYTOWN, outrun four wide for a half, came out seven or eight wide leaving the turn, loomed a threat for the final furlong but lacked a further account. ARVILLA PRISCILLA, outrun to the stretch, was between foes four wide for the drive and improved position. GENTLY raced forwardly between foes from early on, challenged earnestly for the lead leaving the turn but weakened in the late going. TIDE RUNNER, outrun for a half, was five wide for the drive and failed to rally. MERYL'S SPIRIT raced forwardly near the inside for a half and weakened. DIRECTIVE pressed the early pace and tired approaching the final quarter.
