**Footnotes**

GOLDEN LOCKET, in hand early while near the inside, edged up on the far turn while between foes three or four wide, wrested command in the upper stretch and drove clear. EXPLOIVACIOUS, outrun to the far turn and four or five wide, moved between horses five wide entering the stretch, angled a bit wider for the drive, then was all out to earn the place. STOP A TRAIN, never far back and four wide, made a solid run into the upper stretch but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. LADY PEGASUS vied for the lead near the inside from early on, reached the front on the far turn, battled with the winner while inside that one into the stretch and weakened. KEYS, unhurried for a half, advanced along the inside around the far turn and into the stretch, reached easy striking distance but lacked a late account. SUN SPUN, outrun early, raced in behind horses, worked her way out seven wide for the drive and failed to rally. UNKATZABLE, well placed four wide early, raced between horses while continued within easy striking distance into the stretch and came up empty. SHESANIDEM, outrun for six furlongs and four wide, angled seven wide entering the stretch and lacked a closing bid. FOR GILLIAN was returned to the paddock for a shoe repair. During the running, FOR GILLIAN raced in contention two wide for six furlongs and gradually weakened. CAN'T BUY CLASS gained a slight edge early while racing in hand three or four wide outside of LADY PEGASUS, battled up close for six furlongs and weakened thereafter. LOOSEENDS, six wide in a striking position for six furlongs, weakened nearing the stretch and was angled ten wide for the drive.
