Footnotes

VALENTINE FEVER, up close between foes early to vie for the lead, fell back in the upper stretch, angled closer to the inside when front-running DEOMOCRAT TAXES drifted out, then came again to capture a narrow decision in game style. DEMOCRAT TAXES, never far back and racing inside, rallied from the rail, took over, began drifting out leaving the furlong grounds and was outfinished. SCHOOL GIRL, well placed always and in behind the dueling leaders to the lane, angled five wide, had aim in the drive and wasn't good enough. RUMARI, bumped at the start by TATUM CHAPEL, was never far back, ranged up six wide for the final furlong but couldn't muster the needed response. TAKING STOCK, outrun early, made a run to reach contention in behind the leaders four wide in the upper stretch but couldn't offer a late account. YESSHESAROCKET forced the pace three abreast to the stretch and tired. SOLO RUN had no rally. EASY PROFIT battled for the lead two or three wide to the head of the lane and tired. DO THE TIGER was outrun. THRUWAY swerved out at the start, was sent up to stalk the pace five wide, held on well for a half and weakened thereafter. TATUM CHAPEL came out bumping RUMARI at the start and was always outrun.
