QUICK DELIVERY close up from the start, challenged three wide on the turn, drew clear into the stretch and stayed clear while kept to the task. HOMEBOYKRIS vied for the lead along the inside, dropped back a bit late on the turn then came again for the place. FOR ALL WHO CONGA close up between rivals, steadied late on the backstretch when in tight, recovered, came out four wide into the stretch but lodged only a mild late bid. TOGETHER INDY close up along the inside, angled out on the turn, came three wide into the stretch but had no late bid. MAX SILVERHAMMER outrun for a half, saved ground on the turn but lodged only a mild late bid. SUPREME RULER within striking distance, came five wide into the stretch and could not menace. BEAUCHAMP VICEROY (GB) alternated for the lead off the inside and tired. KENNESSEY was no threat.
