LEW AND MIKE set the pace off the inside, repulsed a bid by MIDAS DANCER in mid stretch and edged clear late. TULIRA CASTLE close up early between rivals, dropped back a bit into the turn, angled out for the drive and made a late gain. MIDAS DANCER forwardly placed from the start, moved up three wide after a half, challenged once in the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. GINGER GOOSE (GB) sluggish at the start, steadied in traffic when eager near the five furlong marker, recovered to be forwardly placed off the rail but lacked a late bid. DIXIE DEPUTY prompted the pace three wide, held on well to the final furlong and weakened. ZOLOTO sluggish at the start, steadied after drifting in leaving the chute, saved ground to the stretch, angled out and lacked a rally. MAC THE MAN forced the pace along the inside and tired.
