### Footnotes

DAWN LANE disputed the pace three deep, opened clear on the backstretch, settled into the lane still in control, dug in to meet the challenge and maintained a diminishing advantage. RIDGESTER tracked the pace three wide in hand, ranged into striking distance through the second turn, kicked on well but was unable to best the determined winner. HALLOWEEN PARTY settled saving ground, shifted out and advanced between horses to move up through the second turn, weaved through traffic in the drive and was making up ground. DONT TELL SOPHIA was allowed to settle, closed the gap four wide, tipped out further entering the stretch and improved position. SUBMISSION (GB) broke slow, was anchored at the tail of the field, wheeled out seven wide but found her best stride too late. SOFT WHISPER vied for the lead along the inside, settled off of the pace, shifted out and engaged the leader three deep, but weakened between horses and gave way. LODE LADY settled between horses, angled to the inside for the final furlong but flattened in the drive. ADJACENT was forwardly placed along the inside, got through entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. QUICK PRAISE was allowed to settle five wide and was never a factor.
