Footnotes

PRINCESS PALEFACE, a bit sluggish to start, settled for a half, advanced steadily to reach contention four wide nearing the stretch, took over while coming farther out in the strip and was kept to her task to widen. BRIGHTON WAY, well placed inside from early on, moved through from the rail to gain the lead at the far turn, held on well until nearing the stretch and wasn't a match for PRINCESS PALEFACE in the drive. WELL CONSIDERED settled inside, saved ground within striking distance until the stretch and wasn't a threat while improving position. MASK gained the lead early on the first turn, made the pace for almost six furlongs and weakened thereafter. EXCEEDTHEPROSPECT stalked the pace from the outside, raced prominently until the stretch and weakened. TIJUANA BRASS, well placed from between foes, raced five or six wide, but tired upon going six furlongs. ACCENT OF GOLD, sluggish to begin, passed only tired ones. SEWICKLEY HEIGHTS drifted in at the start and was checked, raced six wide on the backstretch and was done early on the second turn. ANCIENT GOLD went up early to press front-running MASK from the outside, held on well until the far turn and tired. RUNAWAY FIELDS was outrun.
