HOT STORM gained a slim lead inside early, dueled with COASTAL FLAG, shook off that one leaving the turn, then was under intermittent urging to win going away. SOUTHERN swerved in at the start, was checked, raced near the inside most of the way and was second best. COASTAL FLAG maneuvered in early to force the pace, battled with HOT STORM while outside that one, was asked for her best at the five-sixteenths pole and couldn't keep pace in the drive. EVERY OTHER MEMORY, never far back, made a run four or five wide into the final furlong and flattened out when the test came. EASILY, outrun to the stretch, improved position but never menaced. YANKEE BRIDE, well off the inside on the backstretch, raced five wide on the turn and was empty in the drive. RED QUEEN, well placed between foes early, raced in contention four wide to the lane and faltered. SHELBIANA KITTY moved to the three path early, raced in contention until nearing the stretch and tired. POUR ELISE gave way on the turn and wasn't persevered with in the drive while hopelessly beaten.
