Footnotes

WESTERN DOLL, never far back, rallied four wide into the stretch and was ridden hard to prevail. DIS MISS gained a slight edge while between foes dueling early, battled for the advantage the remainder, was bumped by TEXAS GOLD DIGGER about the sixteenth pole when that one leaned in and continued gamely to save the place. BRIGETTE'S DREAM, outrun for a half, advanced six wide into the stretch and was going well at the end. READY AND TOUGH, five wide into the stretch, angled to the rail in the final furlong and offered a mild gain. TEXAS GOLD DIGGER forced the pace from early on while three abreast, leaned in and bumped DIS MISS soundly nearing the final sixteenth and tired. CEDAR SUMMER was outrun to the stretch and never a threat while slightly improving position. SUSAN'S SONG followed the leaders in a striking position five wide for a half and faltered. A CALL FOR GERTIE, used inside early while contesting the pace, tired on the turn.
