Footnotes

MOTION gained the lead early, edged in to make the pace under light rating while two or three wide, moved clear on the far turn and continued under strong handling. SUGAR COOKIE worked her way in between foes early, raced under light restraint four wide, edged up outside the winner nearing the stretch but couldn't challenge in the drive as second best. MAGNIFICENT MISS, unhurried for a half, made a run four or five wide to reach easy striking distance upon going six furlongs but was empty when straightened into the stretch. CANDY MA'AM, well placed from early on while following the leaders four or five wide, flattened out in the drive. TWO SKATS, forwardly placed near the inside to the far turn, gradually weakened. TERRI'S CHARMER, bumped at the start by BEST MOM and steadied in tight quarters, wasn't a factor. ALBERT'S BRIDE, well placed three or four wide for six furlongs, couldn't keep pace. BEST MOM came out at the break bumping TERRI'S CHARMER, then never was prominent. MILITARY CASH angled in early to press front-running MOTION, held on well to the end of the backstretch and faded.
