**Footnotes**

GIANT BASIL broke in front, settled in hand four wide, was never far back, took over leaving the eighth pole and drove clear. BULLY FOR YOU angled in early to vie for the lead three or four wide, gained a slight edge upon going a half, was headed by the winner in the final furlong and continued on gamely to save the place. ELECTRIC CHANT settled inside early, was outrun to the far turn, circled foes eight wide into the stretch and was going well at the end. LOGARITIMO (ARG), well placed when maneuvered in early, battled four wide on even terms into the final furlong and couldn't sustain the needed momentum. CIRQUE DU SOLEIL (ARG), well placed in behind the dueling leaders to the stretch, angled out for the drive and was empty. CATMAN RUNNING raced near the inside to the stretch, angled four wide for the drive and flattened out. CAT AND A HALF raced in contention four or five wide to the head of the stretch and weakened. ART OF DIPLOMACY failed to menace. CAT SHAKER gained a slim lead two wide early while battling inside of BULLY FOR YOU, held on well for six furlongs and weakened. SAY IT SON broke awkwardly and was outrun. THE START OF THE RACE WAS DELAYED IN ORDER FOR CAT SHAKER TO HAVE HIS BRIDLE REPLACED.
