MEAL PENALTY settled in behind foes early, raced near the rail on the turn, split rivals three or four wide in the upper stretch, took over, then was all out to last. UNBRIDLED VICAR, outrun four wide to the turn, rallied between horses six wide into the stretch and missed. CELINA SLEW, outrun three wide for a half, circled horses ten wide when straightened for the drive and was going well at the end. PULASKI RUNNER raced near the inside from early on, made a bold run from the rail into the final furlong and wasn't good enough. SARATOGA SEVEN, up close early, moved three wide to gain a slight edge on the turn, battled gamely into the final furlong and weakened. MR. FLAMBOYANT raced in contention five or six wide to the head of the stretch and came up empty. IMPERIUM went up to vie for the lead three abreast early, raced up close to the final furlong and flattened out. P. BASS, within striking distance and five wide for a half, fanned eight wide into the stretch and tired. ALTERED attended the pace from between foes for a half and couldn't keep pace. VINNY V. raced in contention between foes four or five wide to the head of the stretch and faded.
