STAKES Bryan Station S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$93,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth and \$4,500 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded or group stakes on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2007, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Bryan Station will be limited to twelve if on the Haggin Course or 10 with two also eligibles if on the Keeneland Course. In the event that the race overfills the starters will be determined at that time with preference given by condition eligibility, beginning with graded stakes winners. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A set of four silver julep cups will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Wednesday, October 3, 2007 with 38 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track.

Footnotes

INCA KING, up close at once and well in hand while full of run, forced the pace outside of front-running REVIVAL RIDGE, took over when ready in the upper stretch, quickly drew clear and finished under energetic hand urging. DISTORTED REALITY, lightly rated while between horses three wide to the stretch, eased outside the winner for the last eighth but couldn't menace as second best. ADMIRAL BIRD, outrun four wide for six furlongs, circled foes eight wide into the lane and bested the others. JAZZ QUEST bobbed while breaking a bit sluggishly, raced in contention five or six wide throughout and empty when the test came. REVIVAL RIDGE moved to the fore two wide early, battled with the winner while inside that one to the head of the stretch and faltered. CHIEF THIEF followed the leaders within easy striking distance four or five wide to the head of the stretch and flattened out. SANDWAKI raced within striking distance three wide to the head of the stretch, was asked and tired. FATE TAKES A HAND, away well, settled inside, dropped back and never menaced. MY GOLDEN OPINION, well placed in behind the leaders to the stretch, weakened thereafter. DIAMOND FEVER raced inside while unhurried, angled five wide for the drive and tired.
