**Footnotes**

INDESCRIBABLE, bumped at the break and forced out, quickly recovered, angled in to stalk the pace in hand four wide, swept to the front in the upper stretch and drew off when ridden out. GULCHIC raced in contention near the inside from the beginning, angled four or five wide for the drive and was second best. TRENZA raced prominently inside to the head of the lane, eased out three wide and was empty late. ANDMOREAGAIN, sluggish to start and bumped by SHEZADDOUBLEAGENT, was squeezed back and unhurried, made a run into the upper stretch and couldn't sustain her effort. SUN SHEIKA, sluggish to break and shut off, was outrun to the lane and passed tired foes. SHEZADDOUBLEAGENT drifted out at the start bumping ANDMOREAGAIN, was angled in to gain the lead soon after, made the pace for six furlongs and weakened soon after. BOFFO bobbled soon after the start and never menaced. SOUTHERN STORY raced in contention four or five wide to the far turn and weakened gradually. MISS ABITA bore out at the start bumping the winner, was sent up soon after to press the pace, held on well until the far turn and tired.
