DEVIL TRAIN stalked the pace along the inside, slipped through entering the stretch to engage IVY CONNECTION and was fully extended to wear down that one. IVY CONNECTION disputed the pace off of the inside, battled gamely through a prolonged drive but grudgingly gave way late. HIGH PLAINS settled between horses, angled out entering the stretch and finished well to earn the show. WICKY JONES settled along the inside, shifted out entering the stretch, split horses and improved position. KRIEGSPEIL was allowed to settle, came five wide to make a mild rally but failed to threaten. BANJAMMER stalked the pace off of the inside, angled out four wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. SEQUOIA WARRIOR contested the pace between horses for a half and tired. GHOST IS CLEAR vied for the lead four wide to the stretch, was caught in tight between horses near the three-sixteenths pole and weakened. WHAT'S THE RECORD broke slow, settled in the second flight five wide and was never a factor. ALL READY saved ground to no avail.
