Footnotes

MYSTIC settled saving ground, responded when put to pressure with three furlongs to run, angled out four wide leaving the second turn, forged command nearing the furlong marker and maintained a safe lead. FORMULAFORSUCCESS settled saving ground while never far back, got through entering the stretch, was blocked and steadied with three-sixteenths to run, altered course out off of the rail and finished well once clear. KADDISH vied for the lead along the inside, settled off of the pace before going a half, came again two wide through the second turn, but weakened between rivals and settled for a minor award. LONESOME STREET pulled to the lead between horses, opened clear before going a half, controlled the tempo to the stretch, but flattened in the drive and gave way.. SPORTY was unhurried into stride, came four wide to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. JUMPIN CHARLIE contended three wide but came up empty on the second turn and faded. PIOUS PREACHER failed to respond. EIGHTPIECESOFGOLD saved ground to no avail.
