KATHMANBLU was allowed to settle, commenced her bid circling six wide, engulfed the leaders through the upper stretch and quickly drew clear. LAUREN BYRD stalked the pace between horses, came three wide to make her bid, was no match for the winner but kept on well to prove second best. CLONEYLASS (IRE) settled saving ground, advanced between horses through the second turn, shifted out for the final furlong and continued on willingly to earn the show. JINNY JUMP UP was unhurried into stride, swung seven wide and improved position through the stretch. MISS INCLINED settled in hand, came four wide to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. CREPE MYRTLE chased three wide, drew even midway through the second turn, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. COME A CALLIN settled in the second flight between horses and failed to respond. PARIS BY NIGHT angled out to make a belated gain but passed only the tiring ones. MS ANNA DESTINY stalked the pace, moved up to engage the leaders on the second turn, but came up empty entering the lane and retreated. ACCEPT opened clear to set the pace, was collared on the second turn, and gave way readily once headed entering the stretch. K C LEE was forwardly placed along the inside through the second turn and dropped out.
