Footnotes

DESERT STRIKE stalked the pace, bid four wide between horses, opened clear entering the stretch and held sway. MOON BACK MORE attended the pace five wide, moved up to engage the leaders with five-sixteenths to run, kept on well but was unable to match strides with the winner. EBEN ZABEEL settled saving ground, took closer order through the second turn, got through and loomed large entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. HEAT PRESS vied for the lead three wide, but weakened between horses entering the stretch and gave way. IN TODD WE TRUST broke slow, was unhurried and tucked in to save ground, angled out leaving the second turn and finished with a belated gain. BRICKYARD KITTEN disputed the pace four wide, but faltered between rivals on the second turn and faded. GHETTO PRINCE contended four wide for six furlongs and dropped out. LUNAR EVENT bore out entering the first turn, was taken up dropping well back, and showed little thereafter. CHARMING CHARLIE was allowed to settle four wide and failed to respond.
