

SHE'S A DEVIL DUE, rated in behind the leaders from early on, worked her way out midway of the second turn to rally four wide, reached the front right at the eighth-pole, then was fully extended the remainder. NASTY STORM, away in good order, stalked pacesetting CASH DEAL three or four wide, drifted out briefly at the five-sixteenths, loomed outside the winner through the drive and missed. CASH DEAL moved up along the inside to gain the lead soon after the start, was rank despite attempted rating by the rider, settled a bit on the second turn, raced a bit green while drawing clear, swerved for a stride at the three-sixteenths, was headed by the winner a furlong out and held on gamely the remainder despite an eventful trip. MISS PICKUMS, never far back while between foes, loomed prominently inside the leaders for the final furlong but couldn't muster the needed response. PLATINUM TIARA, checked lightly along the inside nearing the first turn, moved out four wide on the backstretch, raced within striking distance but was empty in the drive. CAUGHT OUT, five wide early, was checked behind PLATINUM TIARA when that one came out entering the backstretch and failed to menace. CURVE AHEAD, six wide much of the way, wasn't a factor.
