LOUDERFASTERHARDER, outrun for a half and five wide much of the way, closed determinedly under strong handling to move clear late. SWISSLE STICK gained the lead from between foes early, raced near the inside, managed a clear lead into the final furlong and wasn't a match for the winner late. BROKE SHARPLY, within striking distance and racing near the inside from early on, continued three or four wide into the final furlong and finished willingly. BILLYBECK, outrun to the stretch, closed a late gap off the inside. BRIDESMAN, outrun early, made a mild run into the upper stretch and failed to continue. FALCON'S PEAK angled in early to press front-running SWISSLE STICK, held on well into the final furlong and weakened. BRIGHTON BULL bobbed sharply at the start, raced in striking position into deep stretch and flattened out. RUN GOOD offered no rally. TIME OUT, a bit edgy in the gate, drifted out at the start, then tired approaching the stretch. PERCEIVED faded leaving the turn. WHEATON HOME stalked the pace four or five wide for a half and tired. BIG QUIET broke awkwardly and was steadied, then never close.
