TAINT SO eased off the inside early to battle for the lead three wide, continued in that position on the track and proved gamely best under strong handling. YUCATAN moved inside early, dueled into the final furlong and was outgamed. WITH DISTINCTION, bumped at the start, forced the pace four abreast, loomed a solid threat through the drive but came up empty. EXCITING METRO stumbled at the start, was outrun to the lane and offered a mild gain. MUTACHI, outrun early, came out six wide leaving the turn and offered a mild gain. CHACHACHARLIE attended the pace between foes three or four wide and gradually weakened after going a half. GLITTERGEM, within easy striking distance four wide to the lane, weakened thereafter. EROBERER came out at the start bumping WITH DISTINCTION, raced in contention for five eighths and tired. SCAT SAM MAN never was prominent.
