STAKES Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup S. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By invitation with no nomination or starting fee. The owner of the winner to receive \$310,000, with \$100,000 to second, \$50,000 to third, \$25,000 to fourth and \$15,000 to fifth. Weight: 121 lbs. The Keeneland Association will invite a representative field of twelve fillies to compete. The field will be drawn by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Nine Furlongs on the main track.

Footnotes

SWEET TALKER, briefly in front after the start, was eased back to race five wide, was never far back, inched to challenge entering the upper stretch, gained a slight edge, then was fully extended to capture a three-way photo. KAREN'S CAPER, reserved near the inside early, eased out between foes on the backstretch, continued between rivals and lacked room entering the upper stretch, worked her way out to secure an opening seven wide at the furlong grounds, then was outnodded in the last lunge. GORELLA (FR), a bit sluggish to begin, settled three wide, reached easy striking distance in the upper stretch, had clear aim through the drive from the rail and wasn't quite good enough. NAISSANCE ROYALE (IRE) went up early to vie for the lead four or five wide, gained a slight edge, managed modest fractions, lost the advantage to LUSA LINE (IRE) on the far turn, continued close up the remainder but couldn't offer a final account. THREE DEGREES (IRE), unhurried early and positioned in behind horse, circled foes seven or eight wide in the upper stretch but lacked the needed response. LUAS LINE (IRE) went up three wide to vie for the lead while rank early, battled with NAISSANCE ROYALE (IRE) while inside that one, reached the front on the far turn, surrendered the edge to the winner in the upper stretch and gradually weakened. SINGHALESE (GB) raced within striking distance throughout while three or four wide and was empty in the drive.
