**Footnotes**

DIVINE RAHY, bumped at the start by NICENE, went up soon after to track front-running CHIEF STRATEGIST, raced under light rating, took over soon after going six furlongs, then was under urging to hold sway. CAMBRIDGE BELLE settled in behind horses three or four wide, early, was never far back, rallied five or six wide leaving the second turn and was going well at the end. QUADERNA, within easy striking distance and four wide, was asked for more at the five-sixteenths pole, loomed prominently for the drive and wasn't good enough. CHIEF STRATEGIST cleared the field by the first turn and moved in two or three wide, made the pace for six furlongs and weakened gradually. HOT CANARY, well placed between rivals three or four wide for six furlongs, remained a factor into the upper stretch and was empty. NEON LIPSTICK, five wide most of the way, made a mild run into the upper stretch and lacked a further response. NICENE came out bumping the winner at the start, raced four wide in a contending position for six furlongs and weakened. MIA BELLA, outrun to the stretch and three or four wide, came out eight wide and passed tired foes. JUST A LITTLE TEA raced between rivals four wide much of the way and failed to menace. MOULIN D'OR raced forwardly near the inside to the far turn and tired. MY GIRL ELIZABETH swerved in at the start, was steadied sharply, steadied again nearing the far turn and never was a factor.
