Footnotes

CONNECTIONS, rated along four wide early, came out six wide to rally from between horses in the upper stretch, took over leaving the eighth pole and drove well clear. EVERYBODY'SFAVORITE, outrun to the stretch while in behind foes, worked his way out six wide leaving the eighth pole and was clear for the place. YES YES YES stalked the pace three or four wide, reached the front briefly at the furlong grounds and failed to sustain the needed momentum. MARK OF SUCCESS, outrun for a half, swung out ten wide leaving the turn and offered a mild gain. SILVER VISTA, outrun three or four wide to the stretch, maneuvered out eight wide for the drive and improved position. J TOWN gained the lead inside early, made the pace while dueling into the upper stretch and weakened. SAFE PLAY raced forwardly near the inside to the stretch, eased out three wide and weakened. RUNGIUS chased front-running J TOWN from early on while three or four wide, held on well until the stretch and tired. COUGAR CAT tracked the leaders four or five wide to the stretch and tired.
