STAKES Buffalo Trace Franklin County S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 guaranteed, of which \$60,000 of all monies to the owner of the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth and \$2,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: Three year olds, 122 lbs.; Older 124 lbs.; Non-winners of a graded stakes on the turf in 2010 allowed 2 lbs.; \$45,000 twice since April 2, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 since April 2, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Buffalo Trace Franklin County will be limited to twelve, with two also eligibles. In the event that the race overfills the starters will be determined with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2009-2010 earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A set of two silver julep cups will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 6, 2010 with 33 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Six Furlongs on the main track.

Footnotes

MIMI'S BLING settled in hand, ranged up five wide through the turn and into the stretch, quickened in the furlong marker and wore down CANADIAN BALLETT in the final yards. The latter opened clear to dictate terms off of the inside, was well handled through a prolonged drive but grudgingly gave way late. WEST OCEAN broke slow, settled saving ground, closed the gap through the turn and into the lane, shifted to the outside for the final furlong and finished well too late. SELVA settled between horses, wheeled out six wide entering the stretch and was making up ground. BROKEN DREAMS tracked the pace along the inside, got through to make her bid entering the stretch, lacked the needed late punch and had the jockey lose the whip in the shadow of the

wire. SILVER TIME was close up three wide, but weakened between horses and faded. COLONY CLUB broke slow and was bumped, was unhurried into stride, angled out eight wide and finished with a belated gain. CAUY'S HUMOR prompted the pace two wide to the stretch and tired. LIFE LESSON tucked in to save ground but lacked a response when asked. KENNY LANE was hung wide and never a factor. BROWN EYED BABY broke slow, was taken in hand and showed little thereafter.
