ENCLOSURE was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, split rivals entering the stretch, quickened through the drive and was up in the final yards. BIG ALBERT vied for the lead three wide, dropped off of the pace on the turn, came again four wide and was making up ground. BALLYCLOUGH set the pressured pace along the inside, opened clear after a half, widened into the stretch, but faltered in the final furlong and settled for the minor award. DUKE OF DEL REY was allowed to settle, came five wide to make his rally but found his best stride too late. RELINQUERE broke a bit slow, moved up along the inside, got through entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. TAPROOT stalked the pace in hand, ranged up four wide to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. DEVIL TRAIN tracked the pace off of the inside, shifted out three wide to make his bid but came up empty between horses. SURREPTITIOUSLY was hustled along four wide, finished with a mild gain but was never a factor. WEEKEND WILDCAT failed to respond. KRIEGSPEIL was through early.
