Footnotes

LUKE OF YORK broke slow, advanced along the inside, shifted out leaving the turn, came four wide between horses and was fully extended to prevail by the narrowest margin. VOODOO DADDY made a long drive circling five wide, poked his head in front with a furlong to run, fought on gamely but was denied in the final stride. LARRY ZIP was away a step slow, angled in to save ground, got through to commence his bid, finished well but was out bobbed and settled for the show. ITALO contended off of the inside, split horses three wide, loomed a danger but lacked the needed late response. D' WILDCAT ROAD was away alertly, set the pressured pace toward the inside, shied from a shadow near the eighth pole and weakened. SHERIFF SILVERSTAR was unhurried along the inside, got through to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. SARGE HUDSON passed only the tiring ones. CANIGOTOO vied for the lead between horses for a half and dropped out. NORM'S PASSION chased the pace four wide for a half and stopped.
