Footnotes

CONSOLING GRANNY gained the lead at the start, worked her way near the inside while drawing well clear, was engaged entering the stretch from the outside by AFRICAN SKYLINE and held that one safe under strong handling. AFRICAN SKYLINE chased the winner from early on while three wide, moved menacingly outside CONSOLING GRANNY nearing the final furlong and could not get past in a long drive. SOUTHERN STEPPER, unhurried early, raced near the inside until the stretch, swung out four or five wide and offered a mild gain. DONANDRU'S DREAM, outrun to the far turn, made a run five wide while advancing into the stretch but was empty late. CATALITA, well placed three or four wide till the stretch, weakened thereafter. ENJOLIE, within striking distance four or five wide for six furlongs, gradually weakened. LADY LILEAH tired leaving the backstretch. CADILLAC MOUNTAIN was finished on the far turn. The rider of LADY LILEAH did not carry a whip.
