TICKER TAPE (GB), lightly rated early while three or four wide, advanced four abreast entering the upper stretch, took over approaching the final furlong, expanded her advantage slightly, then held sway under strong handling. BARANCELLE (FR) settled inside early, moved two or three wide on the second turn, angled outside the winner in the final furlong to be four or five wide and finished well for the place. RIVER BELLE (GB) moved to the fore early, raced two or three wide while accomplishing a modest pace, edged clear on the backstretch, expanded her advantage between calls approaching the final quarter, then couldn't last. PHANTOM WIND, within easy striking distance while following the leaders four wide into the final furlong, lacked a final response. MAMBO SLEW, well placed inside from the start, inched up a bit leaving the backstretch, eased out to continue prominently from between foes three or four wide into the stretch and came up empty. HUMOROUS MISS, outran early and three wide, eased out five abreast on the backstretch, continued in that position on the course much of the remainder and failed to rally. ISLAND SAND bobbed at the start, was a bit rank during the run to the first turn while prompting a modest pace outside of front-running RIVER BELLE (GB), settled on the backstretch, continued in a striking position for seven furlongs and weakened thereafter.
