SAINT KRIS came out bumping with FLOATING ISLAND at the start, went up soon after to press front-running SAINTLY SCOUT three or four wide, took over nearing the stretch, moved clear and widened under energetic hand urging. FLOATING ISLAND, bumped from both sides in tight quarters after the start, settled inside, eased out four or five wide to advance approaching the stretch but wasn't a match for the winner in the lane as second best. SAINTLY SCOUT gained the advantage early, made the pace two or three wide for six furlongs and gradually weakened. PROMISED, four or five wide and outrun to the far turn, made a mild run to reach contention nearing the stretch but failed to continue. MAMA I'M HOME tired on the far turn. VANTAGE leaned in at the start bumping FLOATING ISLAND, stalked the pace four or five wide until approaching the stretch and tired. GOUGE faded leaving the backstretch.
