**Footnotes**

PADDY'S DAISY, in hand early while tracking the leaders four wide, inched to challenge on the far turn, gained a narrow lead, then gamely withstood MAY GATOR in a stiff drive. MAY GATOR, unhurried early, followed the pace five wide, engaged the winner while outside that one leaving the furlong grounds and couldn't get up. LENATAREESE, within easy striking distance always, was between foes entering the far turn, advanced six wide into the stretch but could gain only slightly at the end. MISS NASHWAN (IRE), reserved early and angled inward, circled foes nine wide into the stretch and offered a mild gain. WATER GAP gained the lead early, edged in two or three wide, made the pace for almost six furlongs and weakened. HUMOROUS MISS, in contention near the inside to the stretch, came up empty. GO GIRLFRIEND GO failed to menace. TEN CARAT RUBY went up early to press front-running WATER GAP, continued forwardly four wide for three-quarters and tired. BEAU HAPPY, well placed two or three wide from early on, moved with the winner while inside that one entering the far turn but couldn't keep pace.
