Footnotes

LEJADAMI lost his footing after the start when soundly bumped and forced out, recovered to be prominent while off the rail, challenged on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch and lasted late. CEASE bumped in at the start into SUN BEAR, recovered to be close up while off the inside, was patiently handled around the second turn, angled out for the drive and was gaining late. SUN BEAR bumped when breaking slowly, was outrun for a half came out five wide leaving the second turn and made a late gain. INK close up while near the rail, angled out a bit for the drive but lodged only a mild late bid. JADAL within striking distance three wide, moved up in that path on the second turn, reached closest to the winner in midstretch but lacked a further bid. CAPTAIN STONE drifted in at the start and bumped the runner up in, was reserved while off the rail and was no real threat. DOCTOR RAP unhurried early, made a good middle move in that path but could not sustain the bid. TOUCH OF SILVER close up along the inside, tired. GONDORF drifted out at the start and bumped the winner, set the pace along the inside, held on well to the stretch and faded. SAINTLY TALE drifted in at the start and bumped CAPTAIN STONE then was outrun.
