ANNIE RUSSELL settled saving ground, ranged into striking distance through the second turn, shifted out entering the stretch, split horses and was up in the final strides. GOLDRUSH GIRL tracked the pace three wide, forged command entering the stretch, fought on gamely between horses but grudgingly gave in. DANCING SOLO attended the pace along the inside, angled out three wide leaving the second turn, drew even a furlong out but lacked the needed late punch. SWEET AND LOVELY opened clear to set the pace, was collared after a half, disputed the issue through the second turn, but gave way readily once headed. UPTOWN BERTIE contended between horses, but faltered on the second turn and faded. KRISTA settled in hand, moved up four wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. QUINTE WEST saved ground to little avail. BERYOZKA was outrun. TERRINE was close up four wide for six furlongs and stopped.
