Footnotes

BANSHEE BREEZE, bumped twice soon after the start, settled in hand, raced four wide in behind the leaders, moved out further approaching the end of the backstretch to secure room, advanced steadily five wide to reach the front nearing the quarter-mile marker, quickly wrested command when straightened for the drive and while maneuvering inside, drew off under a hand ride as much the best. RUNUP THE COLORS, outrun for nearly six furlongs and saving ground, angled out about the five-sixteenths pole, advanced five wide into the stretch and couldn't menace the winner while earning the place. ALDIZA moved up early to stalk the leaders four or five wide, moved with BANSHEE BREEZE while on even terms inside that one on the second turn but flattened out badly in the drive. FRENCH BRAIDS, well placed for six furlongs, failed to keep pace while maintaining her position. DANCE FOR THEE was finished after seven furlong. MINISTER'S MELODY, a bit difficult to load into the gate, came out at the start bumping the winner twice, then was outrun. VALID BONNET pressed front-running BIDDING TIME for a half and tired. BIDDING TIME made the pace for six furlongs and gave way readily soon after.
